

**CITY OF LYNNVIEW
ORDINANCE NO.3, SERIES 2026 - 2027**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, KENTUCKY, AD VALOREM TAX ASSESSMENT FOR THE CITY OF LYNNVIEW, KENTUCKY, AND THE LEVY OF AN ANNUAL SPECIAL AD VALOREM TAX OF \$.10 PER \$100.00 OF ASSESSED VALUE OF ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF LYNNVIEW FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE COST OF GARBAGE COLLECTION, TO BE EFFECTIVE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2026.

BE IT ORDAINED, By the City Council of the City of Lynnview, Jefferson County, Kentucky, pursuant to KRS §65.125 as follows:

SECTION 1:

The Special Ad Valorem Tax rate for the City of Lynnview is hereby levied and fixed for the year 2026 at a rate of \$0.10 per \$100.00 of value of all taxable real and personal property in said City as assessed by the Jefferson County Property Valuation Administrator as of July 1, 2026.

SECTION 2:

Said property taxes shall be due and payable to the office of the City Clerk/Tax Collector in the same manner as other Ad Valorem Taxes levied by the City.

SECTION 3:

Said tax shall be an annual tax, to be effective for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, the proceeds of which shall be used exclusively to defray the costs of garbage collection and are to be accounted for in a separate account.

SECTION 4:

Said tax shall be in addition to any other tax rates levied by the City of Lynnview.

SECTION 5:

This Ordinance shall be published according to law.

SECTION 6:

This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.

SECTION 7:

Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance or any part of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

SECTION 8:

Should any section, clause, line, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance be held unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, the same shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
